The conference schedule is as follows:

Thursday 3 August: Paid tutorials (tutorials will be organised separately and we are

not yet taking expressions of interest for these -- stay tuned!)

Friday 4 August: Specialist track day (e.g. miniconfs and seminars)

Saturday 5 August: Conference main track day one Sunday 6 August: Conference main track day two Monday 7 August: Sprints and workshops day one Tuesday 8 August: Sprints and workshops day two

This call is open to all, so that any person or group wishing to organise an event may apply. Organisers of events in previous years wishing to run their events again still need to apply as part of this process. The organising committee will review and select the events to include in the PyCon Australia 2017 program. Event organisers will be part of the organising team.

Types of events that could be included (other ideas are welcome!):

- Up to four Specialist Tracks on Friday 4 August (e.g. DjangoCon, Education seminar)
- Workshops running in parallel with the sprints (e.g. DjangoGirls, Young Coders)
- Associated events run independently, but taking advantage of the presence of a large contingent of Pythonistas in Melbourne (e.g. Software Carpentry workshops)
- Icebreaker events for the opening evening or other social events. Please note, there
  will be no officially organised conference dinner this year.

These events have been hailed as a major highlight by conference attendees and rely on community members coming forward to help organise them.
